1. Introduction

1.1 The focus of the Evaluation

2. Summary of School Self Evaluation findings

2.1 Our school has strengths in the following areas:

Strengths:

- We have excellent resources and a good quantity of books to choose from.
- Very wide selection of concrete materials.
- Parents are supportive of the work the school is doing with Maths
- School grounds and environment provide ample opportunities for active Maths lessons and Maths trails.

Our school has decided to priortise the following areas of development:

- The implementation of a specific 'mental maths' timeslot in teacher's timetable from Junior to 6th Class throughout the year. All class teachers will implement this strategy.
- Agreed whole school policies in relation to Maths concepts/ language.
- Increase Maths games with the incorporation of ICT.
- Integrate Maths with other curricula areas where applicable.
- Scratch incorporated into Maths lessons in the senior room during Term 1.
- Inform parents/ children of the methods we use when teaching Maths via our website (Videos will be posted to the website to help parents/ children).
- Publicise Maths Week within the school. This will increase the awareness of the importance of Maths within the school.

- List of Maths websites and App's will be placed on the Maths page of the school website for the parents and childrens' benefit.
- Organisation of Maths resources, a list of resources will all be made and the resources will placed in a general area for easy access to staff.
- "Maths for fun"- playing/ design of Maths games.

Our School has set the following targets for improvement which are related to pupils' achievement and has identified the following actions which will help in achieving those targets over the next three years.
